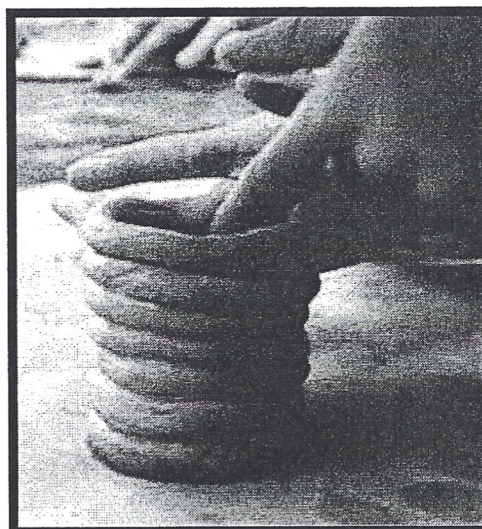
Time frame: 6 week program
